Now we return with the shepherds to the flocks and fields of our lives, renewed in hope, filled with joy. By God's grace revealed in this holy child we have been made into herald angels singing God's praise and announcing this good news of peace for all the earth. And whatever we would do for the Christ-child, we do now for our neighbor, because this Savoir, Messiah, and Lord is born for us and for all. Our Savior's face shines now not from the manger bed, but through the face of every neighbor in all the earth. As Howard Thurman writes the work of Christmas begins.


