

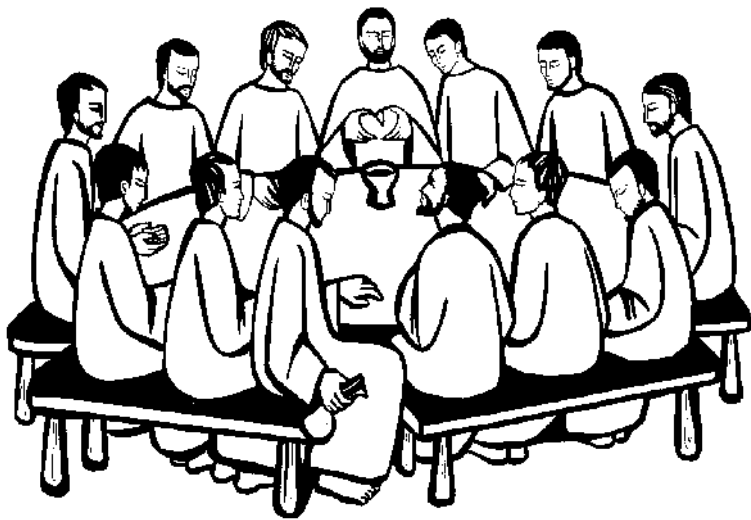
A Prayer
