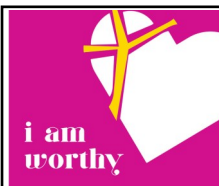

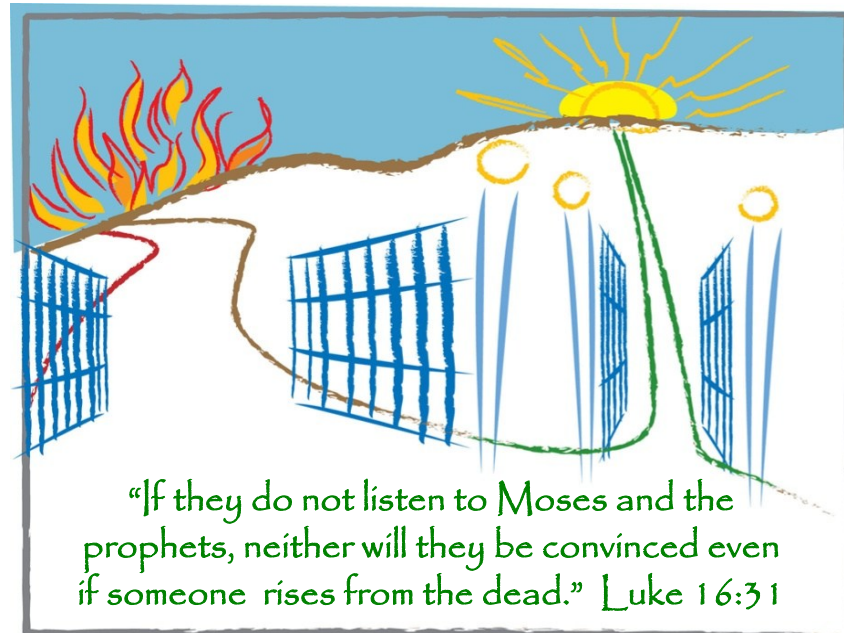
2026 Women of the ELCA Triennial Gathering July 16-19, 2026 in Des Moines, IA
