Trinity Tidings

For as long as I can remember I have always been proud to be part of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA). Growing up not being a sports fan or having strong brand loyalty to a particular product, I found great joy in being part of team ELCA and was thrilled when I finally found a cream denim shirt with the ELCA logo on it during my seminary years.

In college when I first began regularly using email, one of the first mailings I signed-up for were the press releases from the ELCA communications office that highlighted the work of the Conference of Bishops, the Church Council, statements by the Presiding Bishop, and other churchwide ministries. From my small congregation in Cheyenne, Wyoming, to the campus of Concordia College in Moorhead, to Wartburg Theological Seminary in Dubuque, Iowa, to all the congregations I have served, I have always felt a strong connection to the ministry of the whole church, from ecumenical dialogues and global mission to the development of social statements and worship resources.

I have participated in the process for the development of several social statements over the past two decades and was passionately interested in the *Renewing Worship* process that led to the publication of *Evangelical Lutheran Worship* in the fall of 2006 (my last year of seminary).

I had my first experience at a churchwide assembly in Denver in August 1999. Living in Cheyenne at the time I was able to volunteer for a day and be an usher at an evening worship service. I followed the work of following churchwide assemblies online until I was able to attend the 2009 assembly in Minneapolis as a visitor. Since then, I have attended three other churchwide assemblies in 2011 (Orlando), 2013 (Pittsburgh), and 2019 (Milwaukee). The 2013 assembly was especially exciting as my dad and I were both there from our respective synods as voting members. I was a visitor in 2011 and 2019.

I am always moved to see the work our church does better together and celebrate the many ministries that are being done by our church for the sake of the gospel across the country and with ecumenical and inter-faith partners.

From August 8-12 our churchwide expression will gather in assembly under the theme: *Embody the Word* in Columbus, Ohio. About twenty people from the Eastern North Dakota Synod will join over 900 other voting members from across the whole church.

Several business items are on the agenda for the week including the election of a new Vice President, attending to changes to the constitution, adopting a budget, and addressing issues raised at synod assemblies for the churchwide assembly to consider in the form of memorial resolutions. The assembly begins with a recognition of the $35^{\rm th}$ anniversary of the Constituting Convention that formed the ELCA and will include reports from church leaders and ministry partners throughout the week.

Please pray for our church leaders, voting members, and all who attend to our church's mission and ministry during this triennial churchwide assembly.

Let us pray for the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, and its members who gather this week in its Churchwide Assembly. Inspire the celebration of God's varied works throughout the church. Instill your peace in the midst of the work you have called us to and the deliberations that will take place. Shape the work of the church according to your will for the whole world. Amen.

-Youth Mission trip 2022-

Carson Johnson, Kellen Westman, & Rebecca Westman (adult chaperone) participated in a Youth Trip to Minneapolis on July 18-20 with vouth from Our Saviors and Faith Lutheran.

We were able to spend our first afternoon at Valley Fair and a few hours on Tuesday at Como Zoo/Como Pool. The remainder of our trip was spent doing hours of service.

We volunteered at Feed Our Starving Children twice. The first time we worked with additional volunteers to pack 30,240 meals which will feed 82 kids for an entire year. The second time we were able to attend a mobile packing event at Target Field. With over 290 volunteers we packed enough meals to feed 225 children for an entire year. We also volunteered at Global Health Ministries. While here, we packed hospital gowns, sorted medical supplies, sorted medical kits into usable items that would normal be thrown away and packed/labeled them to be sent to partners in Africa. Our final stop was the Neighborhood Church in Fargo to drop off the cereal and mac-n-cheese donations to refill their in-house food pantry. In addition, we were able to help distribute food to over 200 families for their pop-up food pantry and do some cleaning of their church.

Thank you for your generous donations of food and \$274 that we could share with our service partners.
