It is good to be back in North Dakota and to be walking with you in this time of transition.

I was born in North Dakota and lived in Minnewaukan for seven years, however, I primarily grew up in Cheyenne, Wyoming. As a young kid I quickly found a home and a

welcome in my congregation that I did not have at school, where I loved learning and hated recess. I grew up in a small congregation with an eclectic mix of people. There were some 40 to 60 at worship on Sundays. I loved my years assisting as an acolyte and washing the communion ware.

In addition to my studies, I worked in the President's Office, served as a Sacristan on the Chapel staff, and worked in the Admissions Office. I graduated from Wartburg in the class of 2007.

My first call was to Faith Lutheran in Wataga, Illinois (near Galesburg). I served this small congregation for over ten years. During the past three years I served three different and distinct congregations Rockford, Illinois, as their interim pastor.

I have heartily embraced the identity of "church nerd". I enjoy synod and churchwide assemblies am inspired by the ministry we do as church together for the sake of the world. In the Northern Illinois Synod I served on Synod Council, as co-chair of the synod worship committee, and as a member of the synod's Rostered Ministers Continuing Education team and Care for Creation Committee.

While in seminary I learned of the ministry of Bread for the Word and the impact of scale that public policy has compared to charitable efforts. I was hooked. Over the years I have prioritized making connections between faith and public life.

I enjoy reading in the areas of current affairs to cultural studies and economics to history. I have become somewhat of a coffee connoisseur and prefer dark roasts. I always enjoy trying new coffees and love supporting local and fair-trade. I relish the quiet beauty of botanical gardens and arboretums. For the past year I have enjoyed walks at Forest Preserves near Rockford.

I love to travel for conferences and to see family and friends. I am fascinated with the wonders of nature from forests to waterfalls. One of my dreams is to return to the Grand Canyon and experience it from the skywalk.

I am grateful to join in the mission and ministry of Trinity Lutheran and look forward to the gospel work we do together in this time of transition while continuing our baptismal call to strive for justice and peace in all the earth.




Dear TLC Council /Congregation, What an ideal day for me to write to you, beloved saints, on this "All Saints Day (11/01/21)"!
