# Trinity "Tidings"

Greetings "Trinity" folk,



Some of you know I enjoy **noting who has written the words and tunes of the myriad songs we sing** in Worship. I marvel that some of them have lived for hun-

dreds of years, and others even thousands (chants, the Psalms—the Hebrew hymnal). Do you think any of them ever dreamed their creations would live so long and feed so many....?!

As we observe the "4<sup>th</sup> of July" and sing some of those favorite songs, I find it interesting to learn the story behind **"America, the Beautiful"**:

Katherine Lee Bates (1859-1929) wrote the verses after a trip to the World's Fair/Chicago in 1893 with other Wellesley College professors while on their way to teach summer school in Colorado. They decided to visit Pike's Peak in the Rocky Mountains, hiring a prairie wagon but had to leave the wagon and ride a mule to the top.

"I was very tired. But when I saw the view, I felt great joy. All the wonder of America seemed displayed there....It was then and there that the opening lines of the hymn floated into my mind." Her verses stayed in a notebook for years, but she found them again and submitted them for a hymnal, which was first printed **July 4**, **1895**.

The **tune**, **written by Samuel A**. **Ward in 1882**, originally for a hymn entitled "O Mother Dear, Jerusalem"...is said to have been jotted on the cuff of his shirt while crossing the New York harbor at Coney Island, in memory of his daughter.

"America, the Beautiful" has been beloved ever since those words and tune were blended, I suspect. And whether we have traveled near or far or not at all, the images created by Katharine and carried by Samuel's melody have a way of bringing us into a place of beauty and peace.

In the midst of these troubled times and places, may the beauties of God's creation—in this beloved Country and beyond—bring you **pause to rest and delight and be renewed in God's wonders and goodness**.

God keep you (there)!
