Greetings Trinity,

Just a quick update of where we are at with searching for a pastor. Shar Gumke, from the synod, was here and visited with council. There are several steps that we need to take. Next, we need to have a forum in which we discuss the congregation expectations, dreams, and accomplishments. We will have this forum on September 26 after church services with Shar Gumke.
